Ensure Data Consistency

- Ensure email fields and other data are complete, no extra spaces

Final Data Checks



Templates are a guide: use or add only fields needed for your election



Ensure blank fields contain no spaces



Include leading zeros when necessary (zip codes)



Add "filtered data fields" (region, chapter) if needed



Ensure "full name" field is exactly how it should be addressed



Data should be one file on one tab



Save final file in the preferred format: .xls, .csv, .txt
