Ensure Data Consistency

- Standardize key fields like name, address, and membership status
- Identify and correct errors, missing fields, or unusual characters
- Ensure email fields and other data are complete, no extra spaces

Monitor Constantly

Remove Non-Eligible Voters

Final Data Checks

-  Templates are a guide: use or add only fields needed for your election
-  Ensure blank fields contain no spaces
-  Include leading zeros when necessary (zip codes)
-  Add "filtered data fields" (region, chapter) if needed
-  Ensure "full name" field is exactly how it should be addressed
-  Data should be one file on one tab
-  Save final file in the preferred format: .xls, .csv, .txt
